



### 2011/2012 New Rules...

1. A, 3/10 @ B-25... Team A's tight end catches a pass for a touchdown. Immediately after the score the BJ sees that the tight end is wearing red gloves that match his jersey.
  - A. TD counts; Team A is charged a team timeout for an equipment violation.
  - B. Nullify the TD; A 3/15 @ B-30.
  - C. Legal equipment; TD is good.
  
2. A, 1/10 @ A-40... Team A goes with a no-huddle offense and substitutes between plays. At no time do all eleven Team A players come to a complete stop. The slot back is in motion at the snap.
  - A. False start; A, 1/15 @ A-35
  - B. Illegal motion; live ball foul.
  - C. Illegal shift; live ball foul.
  
3. A, 2/10 @ B-35... Immediately following the completed pass play at the B-31, the BJ realizes Team B played with 12 players.
  - A. A, 1/10 @ B-20

  - C. A, 2/1 @ B-26
  
4. A, 4/Goal @ B-5... Team A's field goal attempt is good. The Umpire flags the Right Tackle for interlocking legs on the field goal attempt.

  - C. Flag pickup; no foul.
  
5. A, 4/10 @ B-15... The snap goes over the head of the holder & kicker on a field goal attempt. At the B-30 the holder kicks the loose ball backward and out of bounds at the B-32.

  - B. B, 1/10 @ B-40
  - C. B, 1/10 @ B-25

6. Team A is behind with 3-seconds remaining in the 4th quarter and the clock running, when the QB attempts to spike the ball to stop the game clock. Following the legal spike, the game clock shows no time is left in the 4th quarter.
  - A. Timing is reviewable by the replay officials.
  - B. Timing is not reviewable.
  
7. Team A is behind with 3-seconds remaining in the 4th quarter and the clock running, when the QB spikes the ball to stop the game clock. Following the legal spike, the game clock show 1-second remaining in the 4th quarter.
  - A. Replay may review and rule time expired.
  - B. The Team B coach may use his challenge to determine if time expired.

11. With 35-seconds remaining in the 4th quarter and the clock running, Team A false starts. If Team B opts for the 10-second subtraction the game clock must start on the ready for play. If Team B opts not to take the 10-second subtraction the game clock must start on the snap.

Team A's left tackle's helmet comes off from the contact. The left tackle continues down field and blocks an opponent at the B-10. The ball becomes dead at the B-6.

20. A, 3/16 @ 50... Immediately after sacking the QB at the A-44, the Team B defender gives a throat slash gesture to the crowd.

21. On a kickoff from the A-35, a Team A player is in a 3-point stance with his feet at the A-28 and his hand on the A-30. Team A is not offside when the ball is legally kicked. Team B returns the kickoff to the B-15.

25. A, 4/10 @ A-35... Before the receiver touches the punt, a Team A player runs within 1-yard to the side of the receiver at the B-30. The receiver muffs the punt with Team A recovering the loose ball at the B-25.

26. Shield Blocking... No defensive player who is in or outside the tackle box may try to block a punt by leaving his feet in an attempt to leap directly over an opponent.

35. A, 1/10 @ B-15... Team A completes a pass in the end zone for a touchdown. The Team A right tackle is called for holding at the B-17 during the pass.

36. A 2/5 @ B-20... During the last play of the 3rd quarter, Team A's QB is called for intentional grounding at the B-25.

37. If a ten-second subtraction is enforced, the game clock will start on the ready for play, assuming there is time remaining in the half. If the ten-second subtraction is not enforced, the game clock will start on the snap, assuming there is time remaining in the half.

41. A, 2/8 @ B-30... On a legal forward pass behind the neutral zone, the Team A receiver is about to catch the pass when he is pushed by the defender. The pass falls incomplete.

  - C. A, 1/10 @ B-15

42. A, 3/3 @ B-25... From B-30 the QB throws the ball forward to the Right Tackle who muffs the ball and it falls incomplete. No eligible receiver was in the area. Team A has no timeouts remaining and 24-seconds remain in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.
- A. A, 4/8 @ B-30; 10" subtraction; ready for play.

43. A, 3/5 @ A-20... The QB muffs the snap and the ball rolls back to the A-10. The Left Guard picks up the ball and from the A-10 throws a pass beyond the line of scrimmage into an area unoccupied by an eligible Team A player. The "Passer" was outside the tackle box when the pass was thrown.
- A. A, 3/5 @ A-20; legal play.
  - B. A, 4/15 @ A-10; intentional grounding.
  - C. A, 4/10 @ A-15; previous spot foul.

### **Running Game Situations...**

44. A, 3/12 @ A-30... The Team A runner advances to the A-35 where he fumbles. The ball rolls backward and out of bounds at the A-32. Team B is flagged for an illegal block in the back during the fumble.
- A. A, 3/2 @ A-40; previous spot foul.
  - B. A, 1/10 @ A-42; succeeding spot foul.

45. A, 4/10 @ B-15... The Team A runner is at the B-9 when the defender pulls him to the ground with a horse-collar tackle. The runner fumbles prior to being ruled down and a teammate recovers the loose ball and scores.

46. A, 2/8 @ B-35... Team A runner fumbles at the B-28 and the ball rolls out of bounds at the B-25. The game clock shows 1:59 in the 2nd quarter.
- A. A, 3/1 @ B-28; game clock starts on the snap.
  - B. A, 3/1 @ B-28; game clock starts on the ready for play.
47. A, 2/8 @ B-35... Team A runner fumbles at the B-28 and the ball rolls out of bounds at the B-30. The game clock shows 1:59 in the 2nd quarter.
- A. A, 3/3 @ B-30; game clock starts on the snap.
  - B. A, 3/3 @ B-30; game clock starts on the ready for play.



48. A 1/10 @ A-45... The Right Tackle is disengaging from his block above the waist on the defensive tackle when a teammate blocks the defensive tackle at the knees at the A-43. The pass is complete to the Tight End at the B-40.
- A. A, 1/25 @ A-30; chop block.
  - B. A, 1/27 @ A-28; chop block.
  - C. A, 1/10 @ B-40; legal block.
49. After the snap, the Center brushes by the Nose Guard on his way to blocking a Linebacker. The Nose Guard reaches out with his hand to touch the Center when the Team A Right Guard blocks the Nose Guard at the knees.
- A. Chop block; 15-yard penalty.
  - B. Incidental contact is not a block; legal play by Team A.

### **Replay...**

50. A, 2/Goal @ B-7... The Team A Tight End in B's end zone is airborne as he controls the pass. Still in control of the ball, he gets both feet down and is immediately hit by a defensive player knocking him to the ground. The ball pops loose upon him impacting the ground. The ruling on the field [ROF] is a TD.

51. A, 4/10 @ A-40... The punt bounces on the Team B 30-yard line and obviously hits a receiver on the leg at the A-25 and bounces towards the sideline. A Team A player who is running near the sideline, steps out of bounds at the B-35-yard (absolutely no contact), comes back inbounds and recovers the ball inbounds at the B-20, where the ball is awarded to Team A. There is no flag for the Team A player going out of bounds and returning to touch and recover the ball.
- A. Reviewable – Reverse; foul for Team A player returning to the field of play.

52. A, 4/7 @ B-17... The Team A QB drops back to pass and he is hit causing the ball to come loose as his arm moves forward. The pass is caught by the Receiver at the B-23 and advanced to the B-7. The ROF by the referee is a forward pass. Replay shows that it is a fumble.
- A. Reviewable – Reverse to 4<sup>th</sup> down fumble rule.
  - B. Reviewable – leave call on the field as the fumble was caught in the air.
  - C. Not Reviewable.

53. A, 4/9 @ A-41... Team A may have contacted the Receiver as he is attempting to catch the kick at the B-27. The ball clearly bounces off the shoulder of the Team B Receiver and rolls to the B-30, where Team A recovers. The ROF is the ball was touched by the Team B Receiver and recovered by Team A. It will be first & 10 for Team A at the B-30. It appears that there was early contact by Team A that should have been KCI and that this contact also caused the Team B Receiver to touch the ball.
- A. Reviewable – award the ball to B for the KCI after the penalty.
  - B. Reviewable – just not sure enough to reverse.

54. A, 2/10 @ 50... A's pass is thrown to the Team A Wideout near the sideline at the B-35. While airborne, the Team Receiver gains firm control of the ball and gets one foot down in bounds before being contacted by the Defensive Back and driven out of bounds. While out of bounds the Team A Receiver takes two more steps before the Defender strips the ball loose as he takes the Receiver to the ground. The ROF is a completed pass.
- A. Reviewable – Confirm the call on the field.
  - B. Reviewable – Reverse to Incomplete.
  - C. Not Reviewable.
55. A, 3/10 @ B-4... Team A trails 14-10 and has no timeouts remaining and only seconds remaining in the game. The ball carrier dives for the goal line and is ruled to have scored a TD with 2 seconds remaining in the game. Replay shows that when the runner's knee hit the ground, the ball was on the ½ yard line. Replay reverses the ruling to A's ball 4<sup>th</sup> & goal on the ½ yard line. If the play had been properly ruled on the field, time would have expired without Team A getting off another play.
- A. Reviewable – Reverse to game over – no score.
  - B. Reviewable – Reverse to ball at the ½ yard line – clock to start on the ready.
  - C. Not Reviewable.
56. A, 3/5 @ B-45... The Team A QB, in the shotgun formation, muffs the snap and dives on the ball at the A-38. The ball rolls underneath the QB as he slides across the ground and the referee blows the ball dead ruling a recovery at the A-38. However the ball pops out from under the QB as he continues to slide along the ground. The "loose ball" is then recovered by Team B at the A-35.
- A. Reviewable – Reverse call to B's ball on the A 35.
  - B. Reviewable – ask the Referee to invoke the IW rule.
  - C. Not Reviewable.

57. A, 2/9 @ B-11... With only seconds remaining in the 4th quarter and the clock running, Team A trails 14-13. Team A has no time outs remaining. Team A is lined up in a field goal formation. The Team B Lineman who is head up on the snapper, fakes a charge between the snapper and Right Guard. The Right Tackle lifts his hand in reaction to the defensive charge. The officials flag the play and the clock is stopped with 8-seconds remaining. After conferring,, Team B is penalized for entering the neutral zone and causing the Right Tackle to lift his hand. Video evidence clearly shows that the defense never entered the neutral zone and it should have been a false start on the Right Tackle.
- A. Reviewable – reverse to Team A foul.
  - B. Not Reviewable.
58. On a kickoff, Team A tries an onside kick. A Team A Player has his feet at the A-46 when he recovers the ball at the A-44. Officials rule illegal touching.
- A. Reviewable – award the ball to Team B.
  - B. Reviewable – Confirm call on the field.
  - C. Not Reviewable.
59. On a kickoff the ball hits the sideline at the B-15, and then bounces back towards the middle of the field where a Team A player falls on the ball. Officials rule that the ball did not hit the sideline and award possession to Team A.
- A. Reviewable - Regarding whether the ball touched the sideline.
  - B. Not Reviewable.
60. On an onside kick attempt, Team A leaps in the air near the sideline and controls the ball airborne at the A-43. He comes down inbounds and loses the ball, after his left knee touches the ground. Team B recovers the loose ball, and the officials award the ball to Team B.
- A. Reviewable – reverse to ball carrier down.
  - B. Reviewable – recovery of a loose ball in the field of play.
  - C. Not Reviewable.
61. A, 3/10 @ B-20... Team A Back runs to the B-9, where he is pushed back to the B-15 and is never downed. The official’s rule forward progress was stopped at the B-11.
- A. Reviewable – as the line to gain is involved.
  - B. Reviewable – no matter whether the line to gain is involved or not.
  - C. Not Reviewable.
62. A, 1/10 @ B-20... Team A QB throws a pass to Wide Receiver at the B-2 near the sideline. The Receiver gains control of the ball while airborne and his right foot hits the pylon before his left foot lands inbounds in the EZ. The officials ruled a TD.
- A. Reviewable – Incomplete Pass.
  - B. Reviewable – Confirm the call.
  - C. Not Reviewable.

63. A, 1/10 @ A-20... The Team A QB throws a pass to Tight End at the A-40 near the sideline. The Receiver catches the ball and runs to the 50 where he is tackled. Replays show that the Receiver stepped out of bounds (on his own) at the A-35 before coming back inbounds to catch the pass.
- A. Reviewable – Reverse to incomplete.
  - B. Not Reviewable.
64. A, 1/10 @ B-35... Team B intercepts a forward pass near Team B's goal line, and the officials rule a touchback when the Team B player in possession of the football falls to the ground in the end zone. The Team B player was in possession at the B-1.
- A. Reviewable – as the goal line is involved.
  - B. Not Reviewable.
65. A, 1/10 @ A-20... The Team A QB is under pressure at the A-15 and throws a pass that lands incomplete behind the line of scrimmage. The referee flags the QB for intentional grounding. An eligible receiver was within 2-yards of the ball when it hit the ground.
- A. Reviewable – Receiver was close to where the pass landed.
  - B. Not reviewable. Intentional grounding, A 2-15 @ A-15.
66. A, 1/10 @ A-20... The Team A Back runs to the A-28 and fumbles. The ball hits the sideline at the A-30 and bounces back toward the middle of the field, where Team B recovers at A-30. Officials award the ball to Team B.
- A. Reviewable - Ball Touching the side line.
  - B. Not Reviewable.
67. A, 1/10 @ A-20... The Team Back runs to the A-25 and fumbles. The Team A Tight End and Team B Linebacker recover the ball simultaneously in the middle of the field. The officials award the ball to Team B. Replay clearly shows that Team A had the ball.
- A. Reviewable
  - B. Not reviewable. B, 1/10 @ A-25.
68. A, 3/10 @ A-45... With 12-seconds remaining in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter, the QB throws a long pass to a Team A Receiver at the B-15 where he is tackled in bounds. The officials rule the pass complete and time expires on the play. Replay evidence shows that after completing the catch the Receiver was down with 2-seconds remaining on the game clock.
- A. Reviewable play, regarding whether the pass was complete but not the time on the clock.
  - B. Reviewable both on the catch and the time remaining on the game clock at the end of the play.
  - C. Not Reviewable.

69. A, 1/10 @ A-20... The Right Tackle is flagged for holding, and the penalty is accepted. After the penalty enforcement, the officials mistakenly indicate 2<sup>nd</sup> down.
- A. Reviewable – wrong down.
  - B. Reviewable – only if the Coach Challenges.
  - C. Not Reviewable.

70. A, 4/Goal @ B-5... Team A trails by 1-point and has no time outs remaining. The game clock is running. Team A is in a scrimmage kick formation but the 25-clock expires before the snap. 1-second remains on the game clock in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.

71. A, 4/6 @ A-30... Team A's punt is blocked up into the air by the Defense. A Team B Player attempts to catch the ball at the A-25 where he is pushed from the front by a Team A Player who catches the ball at the A-25. The Team A player runs to the A-42 where he is tackled. During A's run Team A blocked a Team B player below the waist at the A-40.
- A. A, 4/16 A-20
  - B. A, 4/11 A-25
