

## 2013 CFO/NCAA NATIONAL RULES TEST

### NEW RULES

1. At the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter, the Team A pass is ruled incomplete. Time expired on the play. Replay may review this timing situation and correct to 2-seconds and extend the quarter.

2. 3/8 @ 50. Team A is ahead 17-14 and Team B is out of team timeouts. Immediately after the 3<sup>rd</sup> down play ends at the B-45 with 45-seconds on the clock and the game clock running, a Team B player is down on the ground injured.

8. 3/2 @ 50. Team A wide-out to the left side of the formation goes 5 yards down field and throws a low block toward his adjacent sideline. The contact of the low block was at 4-o'clock. The play gains 8 yards to the B-42.

9. Team A is trailing when the QB spikes the ball to stop the clock at the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter. Only two seconds remained on the game clock when the ball was ready for play & snapped by the Team A QB. Game clock shows 0:00 at the end of the play.

23. 2/Goal @ B-4. The ball carrier becomes airborne at the B-2. His first contact with the ground is out-of-bounds several yards beyond the goal line. The ball, in his possession, passed completely outside the pylon. Ruling...

27. Team B player intercepts a forward pass at the B-5 yard line and continues toward the goal line where he fumbles at the B-2. A teammate recovers at the B-1 and his momentum takes him into the end zone where he is tackled.

B. Momentum rules apply; B 1/10 @ B-1  
C. Safety; 2 points for Team A
28. Team A punts and the kick is muffed by a Team B player at the B-5 yard line. The ball continues into the end zone where a Team B player falls on the ball.  
A. Touchback; Team B's ball at the 20-yard line

29. 4/5 @ 50. Team A punts and the kick is first muffed by a Team B player at the B-10. At the B-5 the Team B player bats the bouncing ball backward and through the end zone.

## **BLOCKING**

35. 1/10 @ B-40. On a forward pass play, the Left Tackle engages the defender above the waist at the line of scrimmage. The Team A Center blocks this same defender below the thigh. The completed pass play ends results in a touchdown.

## **REPLAY**

46. On a pass play over the middle the receiver is hit such that the covering officials flags the defender for a high targeting hit on a defenseless player and ejects the player from the game. Replay has clear video knowledge that the hit was not to the head or neck area.

49. Team A's Free Kick is muffed by the Receiver at the B-10. The ball bounces forward and is subsequently touched by a number of players of both teams. A Team A player finally secures possession at the 15-yard line and runs it into the end zone where the officials award him a touchdown.
- A. Reviewable – Reverse to A, 1/10 @ B-15
  - B. Legal Play - Touchdown for A
  - C. Not a Reviewable Play
50. 1/10 @ A-20. The QB throws a backward pass that is ruled forward and incomplete. The ball bounces around and nobody recovers the ball in the immediate continuing action.
- A. Reviewable – backward versus forward passes are always reviewable
  - B. Not Reviewable – as there is no clear recovery
51. 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter with 0:25 seconds remaining. The Team A runner is ruled down inbounds, short of the line-to-gain. The Team A head coach immediately begins to signal timeout to the officials at the 0:25 mark on the clock. The HL acknowledges with his signal the timeout request at the 0:20 mark of the quarter. The replay official's video evidence includes the timeout signal by an official in the case where the game clock should have stopped for a requested team timeout.

52. On an onside kick attempt a kicking team player leaps near the sideline at the A-47 possesses the ball and when he lands O/B the ball becomes loose and hits the ground. Officials rule recovery – Team A's ball at the A-47.

53. 3/10 @ B-20. Runner gets to the B-9 where he is stopped and pushed back to the B-14. The officials rule forward progress and place the ball at the B-11. 4<sup>th</sup> and 1 yard to go.



- A. Forward Progress is not Reviewable
  - B. Reviewable as it involved the line to gain – A, 1/GOAL @ B-9
54. If there is a question of whether the catch has been completed, if the receiver is going to the ground immediately during the process of making the catch whether on his own or due to contact by an opponent and loses the ball, then the pass is incomplete.
- A. False Statement
  - B. True Statement
55. 3/10 @ A-30. The Receiver controls the ball at the sideline at the 50-yard line with his back to the sideline. His right toe comes down inbounds then in the normal motion of taking a step, his heel comes down O/B. The covering official rules the pass complete
- A. Reviewable – confirm the call
  - B. Reviewable – reverse to incomplete
  - C. Not Reviewable
56. 1/10 @ A-30. The runner goes around the right end and is near the sideline when he is hit and fumbles. The ball is recovered by the defensive back but the official rules that the recovering player was O/B at the time of recovery. Video evidence shows he was inbounds.

  - B. Reviewable but you cannot change where the officials spot the ball – only if they failed to recognize that it was the 4<sup>th</sup> down fumble rule
  - C. Review – place the ball at the B-11 and award the ball to B, 1/10
58. 3/8 @ B-8. The ball carrier runs around end and is headed for the pylon. He is hit as he dives for the End Zone and as the ball crosses the goal line extended he reaches out with his foot and touches the pylon. The covering official rules him O/B at the half-yard line.
- A. Reviewable – Touchdown
  - B. Reviewable – play called correctly as the ball is not over or inside the pylon

62. 4/7 @ B-20. Team A is attempting a field goal. Three defensive players are lined up in front of the right guard. At the snap two of the defensive players contact the guard while the 3<sup>rd</sup> leaps to try and block the kick. The field goal is unsuccessful
- A. A, 4/2 @ B-15
  - B. Legal Play... B, 1/10 @ B-20
  - C. A, 1/Goal @B-10
63. 4/15 @ B-45. Punt is muffed on the B-19 by the receiver and is rolling at the B-16 when an official blows the whistle. A Team B player is called for holding on the B-22 during the down.
- A. B, 1/10 @ B8
  - B. Whistle is ignored B, 1/10 @ B-12 after enforcing the holding penalty
  - C. 4/5 @ B-35 after administration of the penalty

64. 4/10 @ B-45. Punt is batted by Team A after it has crossed the Goal Line but not touched in the End Zone. The ball rolls to the B4 where a Receiver picks up the ball and runs it out to the B21. Team A Tackle is called for holding prior to the punt.
- A. B, 1/10 @ B-14
  - B. B, 1/10 @ B-31
  - C. Team A penalty can only be accessed at the previous spot
65. 4/10 @ A-20. The punter muffs the snap and the ball rolls to the A-5 where a Team B player bats the ball forward to keep the punter from recovering. The ball rolls into the end zone where it is muffed over the end line.
- A. A, 4/10 @ A-20 after bat enforced from the A-5
  - B. Safety

66. 4/6 @ A-30. The punt is muffed into the air by the Team B receiver at the B-35. As he attempts to catch the ball, he is blocked by a kicking team player. The kicking team recovers on the B-21.
