### Spring Exam #12

Due date: June 3, 2013

1. 4/4 @ B-45. With 1:55 remaining in the fourth period and Team A trailing 21-20, A12 throws a pass that is intercepted by B21 at the B-35. B21 returns to midfield where he runs out of bounds and tosses the ball at A15 who had pursued him. B66 was offside at the snap. Clock status?
2. 3/6 @ B-8. A12's pass is intercepted in the end zone by B3 where he is tackled. Before the pass was thrown B22 held eligible receiver A88 at the B-4. Defensive player B55 tipped the pass in the backfield.
3. A7 kicks off from the A-35 with six team A players to his left and four team A players to his right. Just before the kick, a player on the right loops behind the kicker. A7's kick is rolling inbounds when A45 pushes B30 in the back above the waist at the B-40 in an attempt to get to the ball. The ball rolls out of bounds at the B-35 untouched by B. After the play, B30 curses at A45 for pushing him in the back.
4. 4/goal @ B-3. A32 runs the ball to the B-2 where he fumbles. The ball rolls into the end zone where it is simultaneously recovered by A24 and B42.
5. 4/10 @ B-49. A11's punt rolls to the B-2 where A46 muffs the grounded kick into B10. The ball rolls into B's end zone where A55 falls on it. B10, thinking A55 has scored a TD, takes his helmet off in the end zone and throws it to the ground in disgust.
6. 2/10 @ B-40. The score is A 24 - B 27. A88 is forced out of bounds on B's 2, after which B96 is flagged for a late hit on A88. Time in the fourth period expired during the down.
7. 4/9 @ A-34. Punter A89, in a scrimmage kick formation, muffs the snap and kicks the grounded ball forward from the A-26, where it is possessed by B22 at the A-49 and returned to the A-45.
8. 4/5 @ B-38. With 1:10 left in the game, Team A's field goal attempt is partially blocked and lands on the B-10. B14 bats the ball through the end zone.
9. 2/goal @ B-6. Quarterback A7, on a "down the line option play" attempts a backward pass to A32 who muffs the ball at the B-10. The bouncing ball is batted by A32 at the B-8, in an attempt to prevent B90 from recovering it, and the batted ball strikes A78's foot at the B-6 and rebounds backwards to the B-12 where it is muffed by A76 and eventually rolls out of bounds at the B-15.
10. 4/1 @ B-21. Quarterback A8 attempts a handoff to A28 at the B-23. While the ball does not touch anything other than A8 and A28 the handoff is not clean and the ball is obviously bobbled around in their hands. A28 finally gains possession of the ball at the B-22 and advances to the B-19 where he is downed. A28 was in motion and moving toward the line of scrimmage at the snap.

11. B25 intercepts a pass in his end zone. While still in the end zone he fumbles the ball forward and out of bounds at the B-2. B34 fouls at the B-4 during the fumble.
12. 2/9 @ B-29. B1 intercepts a pass in B's end zone. While he is attempting to advance, A2 grasps and twist B1's facemask causing B1 to fumble from the end zone into the field of play where it is recovered by B2 at the B-5. Prior to B2's recovery B3 blocked A1 below the waist at the B-12.
13. 3/9 @ B-30. Quarterback A1 throws a screen pass to flanker A22 at the B-32. The ball bounces off his hands into the hands of A88 at the B-25 where he is downed. LB B55 contacts A88 prior to the ball getting to him, but A88 completes the catch anyway.
14. 4/10 @ A-40. B44 signals for a fair catch on B's 20. Teammate B39 sees the fair catch signal and is on B's 23 facing B44 ready to recover in case B44 muffs the ball. A88 pushes B39 in the back on B's 23 to get into position also in case B44 muffs the ball. B44 does muff the ball, recovers on B's 8 and immediately takes a step out of bounds on B's 9.
15. 4/5 @ B-45. B1 catches A1's punt at the B-8 and runs to the B-40. While the kick is in the air, B2 blocks gunner A2 in the back at the B-15. Receiver B3, lined up 10 yards in front of B1, gives a quick fair catch signal at the B-20, but no official sees the signal. The Team A coach sees the signal and charges the LJ well after the play is over, coming out to the numbers.
