
TACKLE BOX

SNAPPER



Tackle Box 2-34

The tackle box is the rectangular area enclosed by the neutral zone, the <u>two lines parallel to the</u> <u>sidelines five yards</u> from the <u>snapper</u>, and <u>Team A's end line</u>. Tackle box disintegrates when the ball leaves it.

2-34 TACKLE BOX APPLIES TO THE FOLLOWING RULES:

Illegal Forward Pass 7-3-2-h

h. The passer conserve yardage throws the forward into an area where there is no eligible Team A receiver. (A.R. 7-3-2-I).

(Exception: If the passer <u>is or has been outside</u> the tackle box, he may throw the ball so that it crosses or lands beyond the neutral zone or neutral zone extended (Rule 2-19-3) (A.R. 7-3-2-VII)]. This <u>applies</u> only to the player who receives the snap)

PENALTY—Loss of down at the spot of the foul [S36 and S9].

Blocking Below the Waist 9-1-6

Exception: 2. (a) (2) In the backfield with **any** part of the body **outside** the tackle box;

Roughing or Running Into Kicker or Holder 9-1-16-a-4-(b)

- 4. The kicker's protection under this rule ends:
- (a) When he has had a reasonable time to regain his balance (A.R. 9-1-4-IV); or
- (b) When he carries the ball **outside** the **tackle box** (Rule 2-34) **before** kicking.
